#### November 10, 2009 Joint ASSE/ASPE Meeting

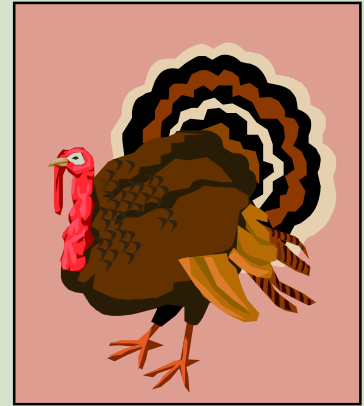

*On November 10, 2009, over 40 guests and members of ASSE and ASPE attended a very informative Power Point training session on The NEORSD (North Eastern Ohio Regional Sewer District) Long Term Control Plan for Combined Sewer Overflows, presented by Richard J. Switalski P.E., Project Manager from NEORSD, shown above.*

*Richard has spent the last 30 or more years at the NEORSD supervising and designing components for this ongoing project, which started many years ago by mandate from the EPA to cleanup the effluent discharges from the sewer system into the waterways and into Lake Erie from run-off and flooding of the system during heavy rain periods. This phenomena occurs when he Sanitary Sewers are inundated and spill over into the Storm Sewers.*

*The system consists of 6 major Interceptor/Tunnels for control of flooding and is not expected to be complete with all contracts finished by 2019. The six projects are the Northwest, Cuyahoga Valley, Southwest, Heights/Hilltop, Mill Creek Tunnel, and the Easterly CSO (Combined Sewer Overflow) Storage Tunnel.*

*One of the projects of major proportions is the Mill Creek Tunnel, a 20' diameter- 43,00 ft.-\$150M dollar hole being bored by a TBM (Tunnel Boring Machine) that weighs 700 tons- digs 55' per day-and generates 17 cubic ft of spoils per linear foot. The TBM costs between \$10 -\$15M dollars.*

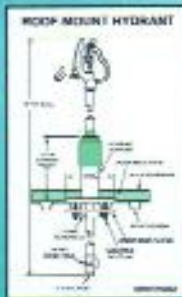
