Dear Plumbing Industry Leader:

Ohio Plumbing Code

The plumbing industry has been in discussion with the Ohio Board of Building Standards (BBS) regarding concerns about the current Ohio Plumbing Code. In particular these concerns focused on 3 aspects: 1) the lack of the direct involvement of the plumbing industry in the code change process; 2) the quality orientation of the code; and 3) the exclusion of some traditionally accepted plumbing practices.

In order to proceed with these discussions in earnest we need the input from all facets of the industry. Please take a moment to reply with concerns or problems that you have experienced with the Ohio Plumbing Code. These concerns could include clarity and interpretation issues, or items that should be included or excluded. In order to help you along we are attaching a list of questions to consider. Of course, your remarks can include issues not mentioned on the attachment. Please include your response in the enclosed envelope.
