WHAT IS THE ASSE 12010 PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS STANDARD?

The ASSE 12010 is a Professional Qualifications Standard for technicaians incolved with Environment of Care, Infection Control and Construction Risk Assessment, developed by the industry through an open consensus, ANSI process.

WHAT MAKES ASSE 12010 CERTIFIED INDIVIDUALS MORE QUALIFIED THAN OTHER PROFESSIONALS?

- Extra certification and experience is required to become certified, individuals must take additional training and pass a third-party administered certification exam
 - End-users can feel confident knowing certified professionals have the working knowledge to perform the required tasks in order to complete the project in a safe and productive environment.
- Must recertify every three years, which includes continued education classes and a recertification exam
